WHAT TO DO IF YOU FALL VICTIM

Report this crime to the local police.

Report the abusing account to the respective social media platform via their official abuse channels so it can be removed or suspended.

If the victim is a minor, the incident must be reported to parents and, in turn, to the school's governing body (SGB).

The victim of cyberbullying can apply at the nearest Magistrate's Court for a protection order regarding the Protection from Harassment Act, 2011 (Act 17 of 2011).
